### TRASH & RECYCLE

The City of Carrollton has revised their rules for trash and bulk pickup and have raised the amount they charge. A flyer was mailed to all with details, and we have some handouts at the clubhouse you can pick up at happy hour. Going forward, the City will only pick up 3 cubic yards of brush -tied and bundled - and 3 cubic yards of bulk at a time. 3 cubic yards is about the amount that fits in the back of a pickup truck. Otherwise, the City recommends you take it to the landfill ... 6 cubic yards for \$18 or a special collection for \$35 if you call them and schedule.

Members can go in the pool area (no animals) but swimming is not allowed. We do not pay for the chemicals needed to keep the pool in compliance for swimming during the winter months.

An irrigation committee is working on a plan to update our sprinkler system. The City will work with us to get all sprinklers working before we are finished with the street project.

There is much concern over pets left tied up in backyards, barking and unattended. There is also concern over pet owners not cleaning up after their pets. Please think about others, take care of these concerns and be responsible pet owners. These concerns need to be reported to City of Carrollton animal control... and let us know too so we can address, as appropriate.
