Dogs will have full run of the pool while their humans can check out a variety of pet-friendly vendors. The Carrollton West Veterinary Clinic will be on-site (10am-12pm) offering vaccines, and Carrollton Animal Services will provide free City pet registrations throughout the event.

Admission is \$10 per dog and no charge for humans. To participate, all dogs must have a current rabies vaccination (or receive one on-site), be registered with the City of Carrollton (or register at the event), and be accompanied by an adult.

Reminder: Humans are not permitted in the pool with their pets.

Saturday 9/13, 8am-12pm Carrollton Clean-out Day

Dispose of bulk waste (broken furniture, appliances, bicycles, rugs, mattresses and small amounts of construction materials, brush and yard waste). Drop off: parking lot on Rainwater Lane, across from the Carrollton Police Department.

Bring a valid ID and a water bill for proof of residency. Event staff can refuse any material not suitable for disposal at this event, such as freoncontaining items (refrigerators and A/C units), household hazardous waste, and battery-operated electronics (cell phones, laptops, cameras, etc.).

Arrive early as staff will not accept any additional material after the roll-off containers are full. Items will be unloaded by hand; no claw will be available to offload trailers or pickup trucks.
